THE PRO-RECTORIA OF GRADUATE TEACHING AT THE FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF BAHIA, in the use of its attributions, makes public the Notice for granting scholarships to Visiting Professor abroad Junior, from April to September 2020, under CAPES/PRINT/UFBA NOTICE.

1. OBJECTIVES

- 1.1. Promote the mobility of UFBA teachers to higher education institutions abroad;
- 1.2. Consolidate and promote international partnerships;
- 1.3. Stimulate the formation of international research networks with a view to improving the quality of scientific and technological production linked to graduate studies.

2. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 2.1. This notice regulates the selection process established by UFBA, aiming at granting scholarships to Junior Visiting Professor, within the scope of CAPES/PRINT/UFBA for UFBA professors linked to graduate programs, participants of the Institutional Program of Internationalization - CAPES/PRINT/UFBA.
- 2.2. The projects priority order will be established and appropriate by Capes PRINT Management Committee - UFBA, due to values available for each theme and adherence to the objectives of Capes-PrInt Notice No. 41/2017, Amendment V/2018, as well as Ordinance Capes No. 289, of December 28, 2018 and CAPES/PRINT/UFBA Project.
- 2.3. As provided for in Notice No. 41/2017 Institutional Internationalization Program – CAPES-PrInt, at least 70% (seventy percent) of the resources will be allocated to partnerships with institutions of countries with which CAPES maintains effective cooperation.

3. REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1. To be a UFBA's permanent professor, with a doctorate obtained a maximum of ten years ago at the time of registration.**



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- 3.2. Professor linked to a graduate program participating in the institutional project of CAPES-PRINT;
- 3.3. O The proposed activity plan must be associated with a CAPES/PRINT/UFBA theme, indicated in the UFBA Institutional Project approved by CAPES, available on www.capesprint.ufba.br page;
- 3.4. The countries of destination must be indicated in the UFBA Project approved by CAPES, made available on the page www.capesprint.ufba.br.

4. ENROLMENT

- 4.1. Entries shall be made on www.sapi.ufba.br page by attaching the related documents:
 - 4.1.1. Minutes of graduate school approving applications;
 - 4.1.2. Registration form for Visiting Professor abroad Junior, available at www.capesprint.ufba.br;
 - 4.1.3. Letter of acceptance of the destination institution printed on letterhead, dated and signed by foreign researcher stating: a) on the acceptance of the research plan or the visit; and b) length of stay (month/year).
 - 4.1.4. List of the five publications considered most relevant, carried out by the candidate in the last five years;
 - 4.1.5. Search plan with a maximum of 12 (twelve) pages, in source 12, in PDF format, including the following items:
 - a) project summary in Portuguese and English, evidencing the objectives and goals that can be achieved, knowledge area and the foreign institution;
 - b) introduction and justification, presenting the current and relevance of the proposed project;
 - c) objectives, with clear definition and delimitation of the object of study
 - d) methodology that will be used for the development of the project;
 - e) description of the infrastructure available, in the foreign institution, for the realization of the project;
 - f) schedule of activities;



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- g) specific results that could be achieved with the proposal development;
- h) potential for the establishment of research and education networks;
- i) projects involving research with humans and/or animals must present an approval document or evaluation request in research with human beings issued by the Ethics Committee or license certificate of Ethics Committee on Use of Animals (CUSA);
- j) bibliographic references that evidence the state of the art of the project presented.

Documents of the articles 4.1.1 to 4.1.4, generate a single file, in PDF format and attach in sapi (www.sapi.ufba.br), in the area pertinent to the work plan.

5. SELECTION AND CRITERIA

- 1 The selection and classification order of the proposals will be evaluated by Capes/PRINT/UFBA Steering Committee, considering the following criteria and weights:

Criteria	Percentual Weights
Academic-scientific tradition of the institution of destination	20%
Work plan considering its merit, originality, relevance and expected results with its development	20%
Project adherence to the theme in CAPES/PRINT/UFBA Project	20%
Candidate curriculum including the five most outstanding Productions	30%
Obtaining support from funding agencies	10%

6. BENEFITS

Provided for in **Annex X** of Notice 14/2017 CAPES PRINT - Fundable Stock Exchange Items Abroad:

- a) Scholarship abroad, with a minimum validity of 03 (three) and a maximum of 12 (twelve) months;



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- b) Travel aid - Round-trip airfare, in economy class, acquired by CAPES;
- c) Health insurance during stay abroad;
- d) Installation Aid, single parcel.

8. RESOURCES

Request for appeal regarding the decision of the Steering Committee should be brought, through SAPI system (www.sapi.ufba.br), within five (5) calendar days, from the disclosure of the result by Pro-Rector of Graduate Education, to be disclosed in www.capesprint.ufba.br page.

9. SCHOLARSHIP IMPLEMENTATION

The selected teacher must present the Pro-Rector of Graduate Education (PROPG) acceptance letter of the destination institution, indicating the period of stay (month/year);

PROPG will issue a statement informing the final result of the selection, in order to instruct the request for removal with PRODEP.



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PROPG will record in CAPES system, the data of the selected teacher. After this stage all the processing of the documents will be carried out between the selected teacher and CAPES.

10. ACCOUNTABILITY

Those benefiting from the aid must submit propg within 30 days, from the date of return to Brazil, scientific technical report of the activities developed abroad.

The accountability of the benefits received should be sent to CAPES, as normatively available on www.capesprint.ufba.br page.

11. GENERAL PROVISIONS

This notice may be revoked or cancelled, in part or in all, at any time, provided that supervenient reasons thus determine this, without generating rights or obligations in relation to any interested parties.

The omitted cases will be resolved by CAPES PRINT UFBA Steering Committee.
